Advanced Fly Tying Classes  
Equipment & Tools

The following is a list of the equipment and tools that are required and to be brought, **to class**, by each student taking the **Advanced Fly Tying Class**. As the classes progress additional tools may be required and the students will be given advanced notice of the requirements.

- Fly Tying Vise (should hold hooks securely)
- At least one spool of 3/0, 6/0 & 8/0 thread (colors: black, brown, gray or olive) (thread should be new)
- Two (2) pair of Scissors – One fine point for close trimming and one heavier set for cutting deer hair, wire or weight material.
- One pair of curved scissors (trimming deer hair)
- Razor Blades
- Two or three Bobbins: One for each size thread. Can get by with one bobbin.
- Bobbin Threader
- Whip Finisher
- Hackle Pliers
- Bodkin/Half Hitch Tool
- Hair Stacker
- Hair Packer
- Head Cement
- Dubbing Loop Spinning Tool

**Note:** Tools and vises will be discussed during the first class. The above list of tools and equipment is recommended for the first class meeting. Additional tool purchases can be made later in the program.
